

# Presbyterian Youth Triennium is Coming !



**Do** you have a couple of youth in your congregation who have shown leadership skills and commitment to their faith? Encourage them to consider applying to be a presbytery representative for *Triennium 2010*.

The *Presbyterian Youth Triennium* is a gathering of about 6,000 Presbyterian youth and adults from all over the world. Next year's event is set for July 20-24, 2010 on the campus of Purdue University in West Lafayette, Indiana. The program includes daily worship services, theme presentations, small groups, recreation, and music. This year's theme is "For Such a Time as This" from Esther 4:14.

### **We are seeking youth & adults to chaperone:**

- *who have shown a commitment to their faith*
- *who are active participants in their congregations*
  - *who can live in a covenant community*
  - *who have exhibited leadership skills*

The Presbytery of the Peaks will be represented by 45 about youth delegates—no more than two (2) per church. Participants must be in high school and no older than 19 years old on July 20, 2010. In addition we will need about four (4) adult chaperones to accompany the youth.

Cost for registration, two t-shirts, room & board will be \$420. The General Assembly encourages presbyteries, congregations, and the participants to share costs. *The Presbytery of the Peaks will pay transportation costs for our delegation.* Now is the time to introduce Triennium to possible nominees and to your church's session, as many congregations are now setting their 2010 budgets.

## **Wednesday, Nov. 5, 2009—Friday, Jan. 22, 2010**

Applications accepted for delegates and adult chaperones. A **non-refundable** \$50 deposit is due with each application.

## **Monday, Jan. 25 - Friday, Feb. 5, 2010**

Churches that already have two delegates may submit additional applications. Those applications, assuming they are in good order, will be accepted on a first come-first served basis.

The Presbyterian Youth Triennium is a delegated event.

The Youth & Young Adult Workgroup will try their best to make sure that all youth who want to attend are able.

Please honor that effort by respecting the above deadlines.

## **Friday, February 26, 2010**

Registration closes. Presbytery submits final number to Triennium for housing arrangements.

## **Monday, April 2, 2010**

Balance of \$420 due.

**Dates for orientation session for participants—to be announced—at least one in the spring.**

## **Monday, July 19, 2010**

Depart via chartered motor coach for West Lafayette, Ind., at approximately 11:00 pm. from Lynchburg and 12 midnight from Roanoke

## **Tuesday, July 20 - Saturday, July 24, 2010**

Triennium takes place on the campus of Purdue University.

## **Saturday, July 24, 2010**

Depart via chartered motor coach for home at noon.

**Caution:** Churches that routinely send youth to the Montreat Youth conference need to be aware that Triennium takes place during Week 4 of Montreat. The bus will return during the night of July 25—the date Week 5 begins.
