## New Mission Grant Applications for Church Sessions to Consider

Your presbytery Mission Committee seeks recommendations and grant proposals for mission outreach within Peaks Presbytery and mission opportunities outside our presbytery. A limited amount of money designated for mission outreach is available from Church Dismissal Funds. The total amount of these mission funds available in 2020 is \$32,000. Our presbytery has previously voted to allocate these funds 1/3 for mission outside the bounds of presbytery and 2/3 for missions within our presbytery (presbytery minutes August 20, 2016). Therefore, the mission funds available in 2020 will be \$10,656 for mission beyond our presbytery and \$21,364 for mission within our presbytery.

Here are some details about how your church Session may submit recommendations or submit an application for a seed grant for local mission service. The presbytery Mission Committee especially seeks to empower churches with smaller budgets who wish to work with at-risk children and youth in their neighborhood.

## Opportunity A: Recommend a mission cause outside the bounds of Peaks Presbytery

The mission can be in Virginia, in the United States, or an international mission work. Tell us what mission has inspired your congregation. Recommend a mission to receive some financial support from this mission fund.

A simple application form is attached. Applications are due by October 1, 2020. Note: Since this is the first year of seeking recommendations for using Dismissal Funds for mission, we do not know how many requests will be made. If presbytery funds three mission projects, that would be \$3,516 per grant. If presbytery funds 4 mission projects, that would be \$2,664 per project.

## Opportunity B: Apply for a seed grant to fund a mission outreach by your Session to serve at-risk children or youth in your neighborhood.

On February 17, 2018, Peaks Presbytery voted unanimously to encourage committees and the Cabinet to study and develop specific action for mission outreach to serve at-risk children or youth from neighborhoods where poverty is widespread. Following this direction from presbytery, the Mission Committee will receive applications for seed grants for congregations in Peaks Presbytery that have plans and a passion to serve at-risk children or youth in their neighborhoods. Several of our smaller membership congregations, which are located in economically disadvantaged neighborhoods, have a passion for serving neighborhood children and youth, but no start up funds. This seed grant fund would allow congregations to plan now for new mission outreach when the virus limitations are lifted. A simple application form is attached. Applications are due by October 1, 2020. All congregations may apply for a seed grant, but we especially encourage applications from smaller membership congregations.

Application for Opportunity A: Recommend a mission cause outside the bounds of Peaks Presbytery
