2020 Mileage Rate Decrease

The reimbursable mileage rate for ministers in the Presbytery of the Peaks will be 57.5 cents in 2020. This rate is based on the IRS 2020 business mileage rate announced in late December. This amount reflects a decrease from the 2019 rate of 58 cents.

The new rate of 57.5 cents applies to mileage beginning 1/1/2020.

Puerto Rico Earthquake Disaster Assistance


