
PRESBYTERY OF THE PEAKS YOUTH COUNCIL 2020-21 YOUTH APPLICATION PACKET







WHO?

Any rising 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grader is welcome to apply using this application packet! [For any interested adults over 25: there is a separate application to serve as an adult advisor.]

WHAT?

Apply to become a member of the Presbytery of the Peaks Youth Council (also known as PoPYoCo), which is a unique way for high school youth to gain valuable leadership skills, learn more about the Presbyterian Church (USA), get to know other youth from the presbytery, and serve God all at the same time!

At maximum capacity, PoPYoCo will have 20 youth members and 8 adult members. There typically will not be more than two youth representatives from any one church unless there are still spaces available.

WHEN?

Deadline for all applications is March 31, 2020!

Only completed applications postmarked by March 31, 2020 will be considered and reviewed.

In applying, candidates are intentionally committing to the imperative dates listed below.

April 25, 2020 • August 7-8, 2020 • November 13-15, 2020 January 19, 2021 • February 19-20, 2021 • April 17, 2021

PRESBYTERY OF THE PEAKS YOUTH COUNCIL FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. Who can apply to be a youth member of PoPYoCo? Any rising 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th graders are welcome to apply. We are specifically looking for youth who additionally meet the following criteria:
 - are an active member in his/her home church and its youth activities;
 - are able to serve a two-year term are until his/her high school graduation;
 - are willing to make PoPYoCo a priority in his/her schedule;
 - are aiming to attend all meetings and retreats to the best of his/her ability; and
 - are committed to being an exemplary role model to other youth.
- 2. What if I can't make a meeting and/or retreat? Leadership at the set retreat are imperative. This is why we give the dates upfront when applying. Otherwise, two unexcused absences within a school year will be grounds for dismissal. Absence from a retreat will count as two absences. Other issues will be handles on a case-by-case basis.

- 3. What kind of youth are we seeking to serve on PoPYoCo? Leaders. Leaders who can... serve the needs and will of a group; motivate not only themselves, but others when inspiration is needed; encourage the rest of PoPYoCo in all endeavors; treat all others with respect at all times; be open to teaching, to learning, to listening, to growing however the Spirit may move; communicate effectively and efficiently; show they care through empathy, sympathy, and awareness of others; be trustworthy in all matters and reliable; accept a challenge willingly; embrace change when needed or desired by others; wholly commit to the group and the experience of serving on PoPYoCo; lead by example in all situations; and always strive to follow the servant-leadership model set forth by Jesus Christ. In addition to those characteristics, we are also looking for those who want to invest in the Church and who not only see themselves as the future of the Church, but truly the Church right now.
- **4. What is the overall purpose of PoPYoCo?** The following list is taken from our Operational Guidelines, which will be given to all members selected to serve on PoPYoCo:
 - foster a deepening personal love for and a relationship with Jesus Christ and encourage the same for other youth in the Presbytery of the Peaks;
 - encourage youth in ways of Christian discipleship;
 - equip and empower youth for mission and service;
 - develop Christian leadership skills;
 - help youth understand and articulate a sense of call;
 - create fellowship opportunities for youth to formulate and cultivate Christian friendships across the Presbytery; and
 - prepare youth to transition out of high school and embrace his/her future, knowing they are loved and guided by God.
- 5. What about transportation for meetings and/or retreats? It is the responsibility of each member to arrange transportation needs to be present for all meetings and retreats. Carpooling is encouraged for all members; contact information is shared at our first meeting to help with those efforts. Mileage reimbursement can be received if needed by going through the Presbytery of the Peaks office.

As stated previously, PoPYoCo offers its members a unique way to serve the church and their peers at the same time. Though demanding, the experience is rewarding and educational! However, we also recognize an important part of our effectiveness and efficiency as a group is the role of parent(s)/guardian(s) and other supportive adults in a youth's life. Parent(s)/Guardian(s): if your youth is selected to serve on PoPYoCo, we need to know that it meets with your approval and you would provide encouragement, support, and transportation to meetings and/or retreats if needed. Additionally, we want to be sure the applicant's home church is aware of a youth's interest in serving on PoPYoCo and know they are in full support of this applicant as well.

Keeping all of that in mind, we ask that you fill out the following information to accompany the youth's application for review to serve on PoPYoCo. Failure to do so will result in an application not being considered.
