Dr. Diane Moffett, during the November 19th presbytery meeting, to learn new ways of answering Christ's call to be a church of action, where God's love, justice and mercy shine forth and are contagious! Dr. Moffett serves as the President and Executive Director of the Presbyterian Mission Agency (PMA) - the mission arm of the PC(USA).

Prior to joining the PMA, Diane served as pastor of St. James Presbyterian Church in Greensboro, North Carolina; Elmhurst Presbyterian Church in Oakland, California; and Elmwood United Presbyterian Church in East Orange, New Jersey. She has also served as coordinator of the Korean and African-American Pastors Reconciliation Project and executive director at Harbor House Ministries.

Active and committed to community efforts, Diane is a recipient of the Sojourner Truth Award, the highest honor of the National Association of Negro Business and Professional Women's Clubs, for her commitment to serving others.

Diane holds a bachelor of arts degree in sociology and social welfare from the University of California at Berkeley, and both a master of divinity and doctorate of ministry from San Francisco Theological Seminary. She is married to Mondre Moffett, a trumpeter and professor of music at Simmons College of Kentucky. They have three daughters and five grandchildren.
