

# Covenant Presbyterian, Roanoke and First Presbyterian, Martinsville Become Certified as PC(USA) Earth Care Congregations

Presbytery of the Peaks churches Covenant Presbyterian, Roanoke and First Presbyterian, Martinsville were certified as Earth Care Congregations by Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)'s Presbyterian Hunger Program through February 2022. This honor speaks to the great commitment that these churches have made to care for God's earth.

To become an Earth Care Congregation, these congregation affirmed an Earth Care Pledge to integrate environmental practices and thinking into their worship, education, facilities, and outreach.

The Earth Care Congregations certification is designed to recognize churches that make the commitment to take seriously God's charge to "till and keep" the garden.

Started in 2010 by the PC(USA), the goal of this program is to inspire churches to care for God's earth in a holistic way, through integrating earth care into all aspects of their church life. The Earth Care Congregation certification honors churches that make that commitment and encourages others to follow their example.

"It is exciting that these churches, both members of the Presbytery of the Peaks, are two of the 276 churches that chose to dedicate themselves to intentional care of God's earth this year. Particularly in a time of much uncertainty and worry about the future, these congregations' activities and commitment even in the midst of navigating limitations brought about by COVID-19 brings hope to their communities. We believe that these congregations will inspire others to respond intentionally to God's call to care for the earth," says Jessica Maudlin, Associate for Sustainable Living and Earth Care Concerns for the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.).

Covenant and First Martinsville join Blacksburg Presbyterian as Presbytery of the Peaks Earth Care Congregations. Blacksburg became an Earth Care Congregation in 2016.

## **Minimum Wage Increase**

The Minimum Wage in Virginia is increasing to \$9.50 effective May 1, 2021. This is a \$2.25 increase over the current minimum wage of \$7.25 per hour. The current law requires an increase in minimum wage on January 1, 2022 to \$11.00 per hour and on January 1, 2023 to \$12.00 per hour.
