

Due to the resignation of our Stated Clerk, a Stated Clerk Nominating Committee was elected at the November Presbytery Meeting to conduct a search for a new Stated Clerk. According to The Manual of Operations the committee will conduct an extensive review of the office and Position Description of Stated Clerk and propose a Position Description and a nominee for the office of Stated Clerk for Presbytery action. The current Stated Clerk has offered to serve through the February 2022 meeting.

The purpose of the Stated Clerk is to serve as an ecclesiastical officer of the governing body as set forth in the Book of Order, Articles of Agreement and Manual of Operations of the Presbytery. The Stated Clerk shall be nominated, elected, and serve a four-year term of office (and may be re-elected) in accordance with desires of the Presbytery, shall fulfill those duties and responsibilities included in his/her position description, and possess such authority as assigned by the Book of Order (G-3.0305, D-11.0601, D-11.0700 & G-3.0104) and the Standing Rules of Presbytery. The presbytery will offer necessary training and/or coaching to the right candidate.
