

## Attention Ministers and Treasurers IRS Mileage Rate Increase

The IRS announced an increase in the standard mileage rate for business travel for the final six months of 2022. The standard business mileage rate is used to reimburse minister's mileage. The rate of 62.5 cents per mile should be used for mileage incurred July 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022. For travel incurred from January through June 2022, the rate of 58.5 cents per mile should be used.

The IRS made this unusual move to increase the mileage rate by four cents due to recent gasoline price increases. Mid year increases are rare, with the last time the IRS making such an increase being in 2011. The IRS will announce the mileage rate for 2023 in December 2022.

Calendars will not be sent to our office from the distribution center until August.




