If your church offers benefits to a minister or employee, the Employer Agreement should be reviewed and submitted by this deadline. (The Employer representative reviews the agreement using Benefits Connect on the Board of Pensions website-www.pensions.org).

Any employee covered by a Board of Pensions plan will need to review their current selections during the time period of October 24th through November 11th. Sign on to Benefits Connect during this time frame to review and make selections of benefits available for 2023.


