If your church offers benefits to a minister or employee, the Employer Agreement should be reviewed and submitted by this deadline. (The Employer representative reviews the agreement using Benefits Connect on the Board of Pensions website-[www.pensions.org](http://www.pensions.org)).

Any employee covered by a Board of Pensions plan will need to review their current selections during the time period of October 24<sup>th</sup> through November 11<sup>th</sup>. Sign on to Benefits Connect during this time frame to review and make selections of benefits available for 2023.
