TOGETHER IN SERVICE – MOVING MOUNTAINS

Congregations continue to report their "new book" mission projects to be shared with other PW groups. In addition to those projects previously reported, below is another project account.

Blacksburg Presbyterian Church – BPC PW had very recently participated in a book project for the children in the Head Start program of Montgomery County. Therefore, in response to the Peaks PW challenge, the decision was made to support the Education Committee of the Montgomery County-Radford City-Floyd County Branch of the NAACP in its collection of new African American History books and its request for funds to purchase hard-to-find books, as well as print online articles, papers, and reports. The collection is being donated to local history and cultural museums for community members to use on-site and for high school classrooms and community groups to borrow.

The NAACP Education Committee chose numerous books for purchase online at Amazon. Supporters were instructed to use a specific link and add books to their carts, proceed to checkout, pay for the books, and pick the mailing address provided to have the books mailed directly to the NAACP Education Committee. The BPC PW purchased at least 33 books and mailed a donation totaling \$250 for the project.

The keynote speaker was the Rev. Dr. Diane Moffett, President and Executive Director of the Presbyterian Mission Agency, who gave a rousing speech embracing Matthew 25 and encouraging involvement in the fight against injustices occurring within our communities.

The Interfaith Outreach Association in Lynchburg was the recipient of the offering, and Shawne Farmer, Executive Director, gave a presentation about its services and programs, including its new program targeting the prevention of homelessness.
