Our congregations are excited as we look toward the future that our Lord is leading us towards.

The person open to being called as our pastor needs to have the characteristics described below:

Leader - Inspire our congregations through carefully prepared and artfully delivered sermons that articulate a clear and consistent theology. **Project** the identity and character of the congregations through worship leadership. **Demonstrate** integrity by responding with faithfulness of purpose and by being seen by our congregations and community as trustworthy, authentic, and spiritually grounded.

Communicator - Present information in a thoughtful and concise manner. Speak comfortably in a variety of settings, with all ages. Advance the ability of our church and its members though active listening. Congregational Advisor - See challenges as opportunities. Work to build trust among our congregations and the community using strong interpersonal skills. Work with others to achieve the churches' vision and fulfill our mission. Support and advance our community outreach initiatives by leading and inspiring others, who work to create unity and build friendships. Pastoral Care Captain - Lead our flock in all areas of pastoral care including counseling, support and visitation for those in need. Strengthen the congregations' commitment to grow our ministry. Demonstrate personal qualities such as compassion, patience, kindness, and attentiveness; all critical to one's ability to nurture and support others.

What specific tasks, assignments, and program areas will this person have responsibility?

Our pastor will be responsible for leading worship at both churches, which includes preaching sermons each Sunday, leading and delivering prayer, administering the sacraments of baptism and communion, and officiating weddings and funerals. This position is responsible for pastoral care which includes both visitation and counseling at both churches. The faith journey for our congregations includes active and continual learning; a teaching process that will be led by our pastor. They will have responsibility for oversight and coordination of activities while working in harmony with the Session's administrative committee. At a strategic level, our pastor will be responsible for leading the congregations in actions that will support the vision and missions defined in our most recent mission statement. Finally, we are looking for someone with the ability to connect Cumberland Presbyterian Church (established 1754) and Guinea Presbyterian Church (1824) to the community by continuing our long-standing leadership role among other churches and organizations in the area.
