What is the congregation's or organization's vision for ministry:

The First Presbyterian Church of Pulaski, VA is presently an older congregation with a smaller number of younger adult members with children. The majority of the congregation are retired and include a number of present or former elders of the church. The church session would like to re-establish the youth group which was headed by our former pastor. The church congregation seeks to continue to feed its spiritual needs through traditional Sunday worship services. For over two years the Sunday service has been live-streamed on Facebook with 6 to 10 viewers during the service and up to 60 at other times. Preaching of the word and music in the service continues to be very important. Our bell choir continues to meet and be active in services about once per month. The church choir has not met since the Covid pandemic . Frequent personal contact with and care of our homebound elderly members is also an important concern. The church session and membership plan, at some point, to restart the Wonderful Wednesday family night program. This includes a meal for all ages and special activities for all ages from 6 pm to 7:30 pm on Wednesdays. The new pastor would help plan and lead programs including bible study for the weekly Wonderful Wednesday program. Church Bible study has continued through member leadership. The present ten member church session and several other church elders are committed to continue to oversee and facilitate all of the operations of the church.

How do you feel called to reach out to address the emerging needs of your community or constituency:

First Presbyterian Church has been involved in many community outreach programs during its long history. The church houses the Pulaski Daily Bread in its fellowship hall including extensive food storage and refrigeration as well as cooking and meal preparation. The Daily Bread operation was established over 40 years ago as an ecumenical program serving mid-day meals to up to 150 persons per day. An average of eight volunteers from area churches and First Presbyterian prepare meals on week-days and collect and distribute food. The church also houses the New River Community Action rent-free in the adjacent Jones/Sadler Building. The Community Action which provides housing assistance, food distribution, and utility assistance. The Emergency Needs Task Force (ENTF) was established by several churches in the area over 40 years ago to supplement the work of Community Action. The church's former manse is utilized as the pastor's office and provides meeting space for the Pulaski Community Partners Coalition and Narcotics Anonymous meetings as well as other community organizations. The church has also provided outreach support for Go Pulaski, a local program to assist local people by completing special projects, the elderly at the Fairview home, and local cancer patients. The church also operates a preschool program, also housed in the church, for 3 and 4 year old children. The pastor's involvement with the preschool program is encouraged.

To be the love of Christ: Through visitation and nurture of homebound members; By encouraging a welcoming, caring attitude of church members toward one another and the community

Leadership; The pastor shall provide leadership to the session and the congregation intended to lead to the spiritual growth of the membership and encourage the church to grow in mission. Member Care The pastor shall consistently exercise pastoral care to all members, devoting special attention to the troubled, the ill, and the dying. Community Interaction The pastor shall participate in the Presbytery and larger community of the church. Administration The pastor shall act as head of staff and, together with the appropriate session committee, shall oversee the work of the volunteer and paid staff.
