Let Every Day Be a Great Day of Service

Last month several members of the Second Presbyterian Green Team joined with other church members in a youth-lead, church-wide intergenerational Great Day of Service. As Ben Brannan, Pastor for Youth and Young Adults, shared in his Pastor's Letter & Announcements, *"…Second Presbyterian will go out into the community to serve in our Great Day of Service! This is our first (of what I hope will be many) church-wide mission days to "seek the welfare of our city" through volunteering at local organizations."*



Four 10-member mission teams spent the morning serving at the Presbyterian Community Center (PCC), Roanoke Area Ministries (RAM House), Mill Mountain Zoo, and the West End Center for Youth. The afternoon was devoted to cleaning up the church grounds and adjacent neighboring streets bordering church property. As Jesus so often demonstrated in word and deed, He came to serve, not to be served.

The West End Center mission team spent their time tending the West End Community Garden. Eight raised beds are enclosed by a wooden picket fence, and the garden was overgrown and in dire need of weeding and trash removal. Started in 2020 to provide food for the community, the pandemic interrupted the garden's care and seasonal harvests. Spring planting can now begin anew.



True to our church's mission, *Finding direction by following Jesus*, the youth- lead Great Day of Service bore witness to living out our faith by serving others. It brings to mind the famous quote by John F. Kennedy at his Inaugural address in January 1961, as it might have been interpreted within the context of serving others: "Ask not what your neighbor can do for you; ask what you can do for your neighbor."

Ben Brannan said it best, "I am filled with joy because we have almost 40 participants registered to join in fellowship and service! ...I hope this day will be transformative in mind, body, and spirit for both our people and the organizations we are serving! This is a youth-led, intergenerational, church- wide event to provide opportunities for relationship building, for learning and growing, and to put our faith into action."
