

2024 Board of Pensions Dues to Remain Unchanged

The Board of Pensions announced that the total dues for the Pastor's Participation benefits package will remain at 39 percent of effective salary. The Medical Coverage is based on 29 percent of effective salary, and the remaining 10 percent is allocated to pension, disability and death coverage.
