Born in Puerto Rico to a not spiritual family, Carlos joined the Seventh-Day Advent church when he was 17. It was there he felt the call to ministry. As a young adult, Carlos moved to California to pursue a M.A. in family life education at Loma Linda University. Over time, Carlos began to re-evaluate his theology and found a home in the PCUSA. He earned an M. Div. at Fuller where he was drawn to ecumenism and social justice, which was to become the focus of his ministry for much of his career. He spent 12 years as associate for ecumenical relations at the Office of the General Assembly and served as head of Christian Churches Together before accepting this new call.

If Carlos could spend the day with one person in history, it would be Pope Francis. He is fascinated at how the Pope holds tradition and progress in tension and with intention. In addition to tennis, Carlos enjoys keeping up with Apple technology.

The possibilities of his new call are energizing. He wants to be a difference maker and has a desire to help the church and these churches be relevant and is excited to explore with them what that means.




