Attendees were also blessed with participation by Associate Pastor, Isabella Fagiani, from Raleigh Court PC, and Associate Pastor, Janet Chisom, from Salem PC. As a special surprise via Zoom, the First Lady of Virginia, Suzanne Youngkin, conveyed a message of congratulations to PW for its continuing contributions to mission work. Meighan Sharp, keynote speaker, as well as author, visiting faculty at Hollins University, and Chair, Roanoke Arts Commission, involved attendees in a discussion of the ways in which art affects our lives.






