As you may know, boundary training is now constitutionally required by the Book of Order every 36 months - and our Presbytery is overdue!

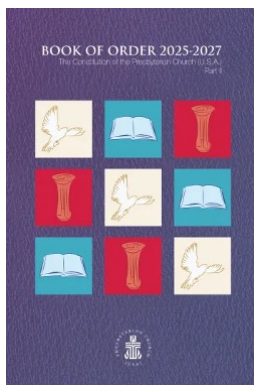
Above are the only times Boundary Training will be available in 2025. Everyone is due for the training this year.

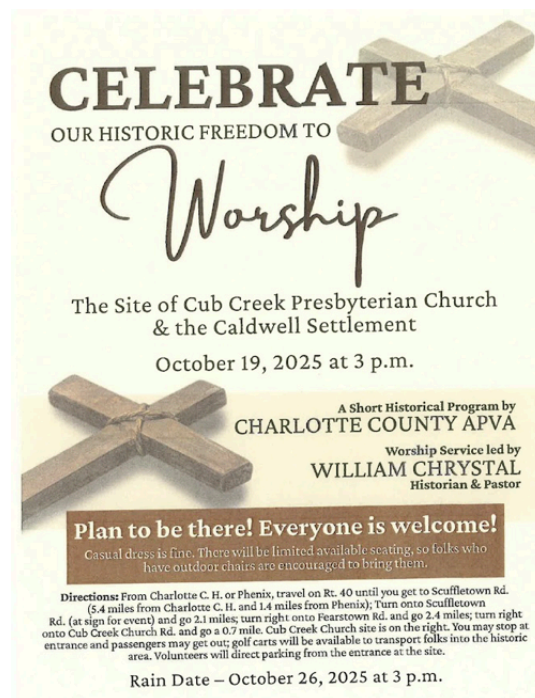
The 2025-2027 PCUSA *Book of Order* is now available. Orders place before October 20 will be

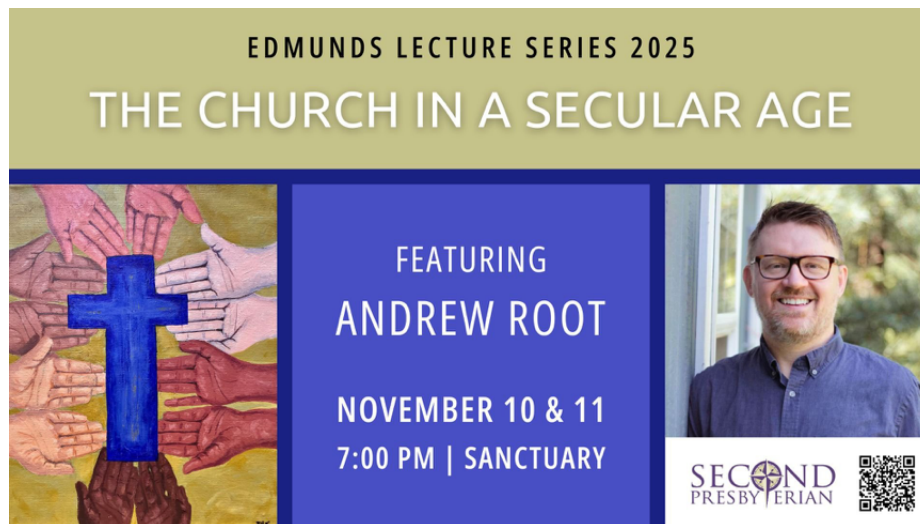

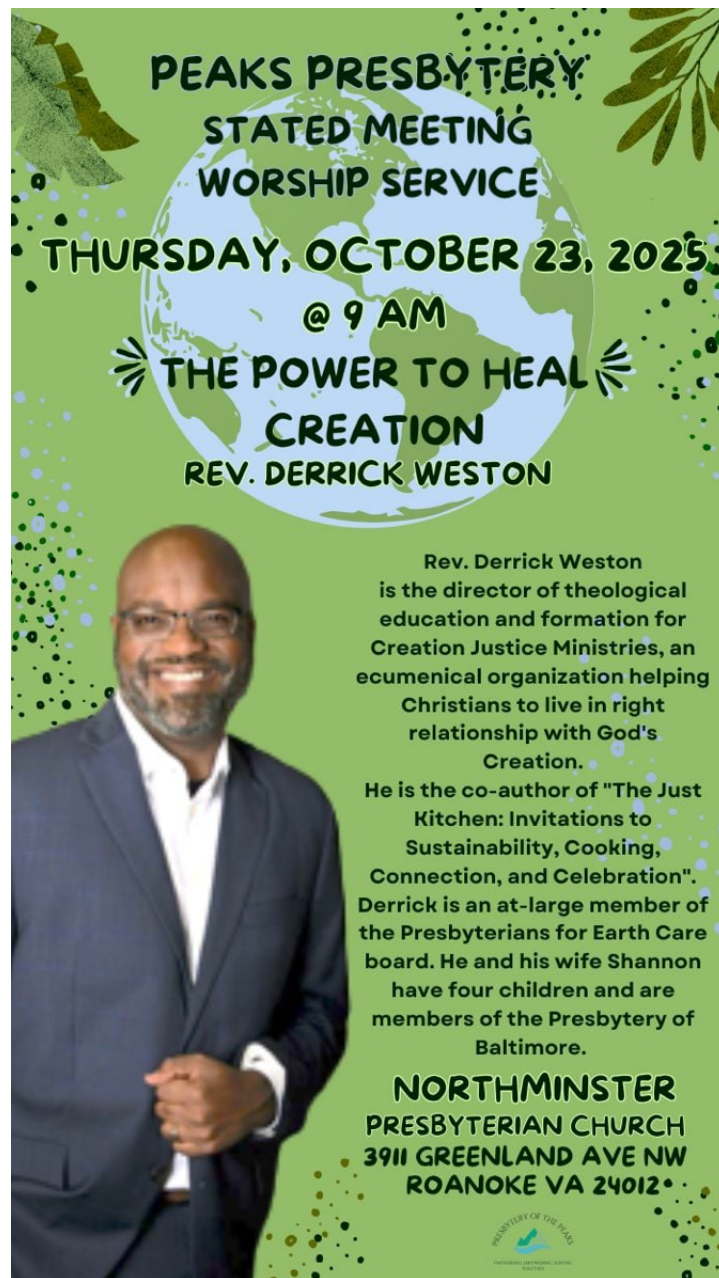
