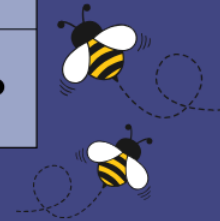
AI (Artificial Intelligence) in Ministry

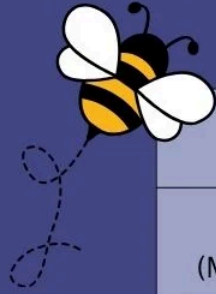

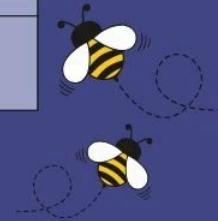

Peaks Grants in Action: Earth Care Grants

Our Covenant Presbyterian Earth Care Team in Roanoke wants to share two exciting projects made possible with POP Earth Care Grants. A POP Earth Care Grant in April 2024 enabled us to purchase a rain barrel and accessories. The intent was to irrigate our giving garden with roof rainwater collected in the rain barrel and pumped into drip lines in our raised garden beds. It was a great learning experience, but with disappointing water pump function, insufficient rainfall, and learning that roof water runoff is not advisable for edible crops (due to possible contaminants), we redirected our rain barrel to serve as an educational opportunity for folks to pursue at home.

We equipped the rain barrel with a diverter from which one line supplies a bird bath fountain and the other has a garden hose to water plants. To make the rain barrel attractive, two teen church members created an original cheerful design. Thanks to their aesthetic contribution, we were able to place the rain barrel and bird bath at the front church entrance, where it creates much interest and enthusiasm for ways to conserve water with rain barrels.

Our latest project – an important one – was made possible via a POP Earth Care Grant this summer. Covenant is one of several churches in the Roanoke Valley partnering with Star City Compost. Our Community Food Waste Collection Station in our parking lot was purchased with the grant. Subscribers receive a 5-gallon bucket from Star City Compost, which we empty as needed at our collection station. Our church subscribes, so not only do all food scraps (even bones!) get composted at our social events, but with commercial composting, most paper plates, napkins, and paper towels (no paper cups) go in the bucket.
